

Planscape - Basic

Plans = the various plans completed, underway, or contemplated. There may already be upwards of a dozen of these. E.g., Downtown Master Plan, Community Health Improvement Plan, etc.

Organizations = that or those organization(s) who are authors of the plan.

Impact Area = those sectors of the community in which the plan is intended to make a difference. E.g., transportation, health, workforce, etc.

COMMENTS:

- Rather than attempt to organize or coordinate the work going on in the community, the “planscape” would seek to depict how the community’s work is already being organized; aggregate and curate that work - tracking impact and participation; and, make this information available for review and discussion.
- The “planscape” would provide: (1) a current overview of community planning activities, (2) a basis for assessing completeness or gaps in those activities, and (3) a resource for opportunities that participants and others might use as a basis for cooperation, coordination, collaboration, or collective impact.
- The “planscape” would be produced by the *Development Information Network (DIN)*, used for the purposes above, and be made available to the public. DIN is a proposed new name for this group..
- DIN would appoint a “*curator(s)*” to develop and maintain the “planscape”.
